	The University of Kansas – Kansas Law Enforcement Training Center (KLETC) complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act Amendment Act (ADAAA). In advance of arrival at KLETC to attend a law enforcement basic training class, any student officer with a disability who wishes to request reasonable accommodation in the class should provide KLETC documentation of the specific disability and a written request for any accommodation(s) the student seeks. It is a student officer's choice whether to voluntarily self-identify and disclose a disability in order to request accommodation. If disability documentation is provided to KLETC for review, the documentation must be completed by a recognized professional capable of diagnosing disabilities. KLETC considers all accommodation requests on a case-by-case review. When the student officer provides a request for an accommodation prior to the beginning of the class, KLETC and the student officer have an opportunity to engage in timely communications concerning accommodation that can be made without causing a substantial change or alteration of an essential element of the law enforcement basic training program, or posing a direct threat to the health and safety of others or an undue administrative burden on the program. When a request for accommodation comes after the class has begun it may be more difficult to make an appropriate accommodation in the time remaining in the class.
