Working as a police or law enforcement officer during enrollment breaks:

Pursuant to Kansas Administrative Regulation (KAR) 106-3-2, implementing K.S.A. 74-5607, regarding provisional certification and working as an officer during his or her enrollment in basic training course, each officer who has been granted provisional certification shall not work as an officer while enrolled and

attending a basic training course only as required by the course curriculum, except whenever the director of police training announces that the training center is closed or otherwise will not conduct basic training courses. At agency head discretion, KAR 106-3-2 allows officers to work as police or law enforcement officers during the preceding specified enrollment breaks.
