Agency Administrators:

Effective July 18, 2022, KLETC will provide all full-time basic training students attending classes on the KLETC campus with a common training uniform. This will be at no cost to the student or their agency. Students engaged in basic training prior to July 18, 2022 will continue with their classes wearing their department uniforms.

Our success in eliminating the basic training backlog, allowing most students to attend basic training within 3-6 weeks of employment, has caused challenges for some agencies to hire someone and provide them with department uniforms within such a short period of time.

Furthermore, common uniforms will allow easy identification of basic training students which can be vitally important during high risk training exercises. This is especially true as we continue to have increasing numbers of people on campus for law enforcement continuing education classes and other disciplines training.

The uniforms will be the same for each basic training class and will consist of cargo pants, polo shirts, and PT clothing with safety reflective strips for outdoor activities. Each student will still be required to bring some of their necessary training clothing and equipment with them. Each student and administrator will receive more specific information regarding items to bring with them when they enroll for basic training.

We hope this change makes it easier for each of you in preparing your student to attend basic training.
