

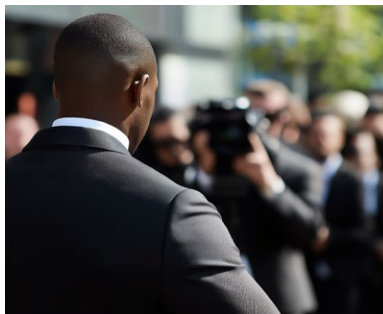

This course equips officers with the knowledge, decision-making frameworks, and hands-on skills required to safeguard at-risk individuals—including local officials, public figures, or community stakeholders—within your jurisdiction or during regional operations. Training integrates lecture, guided discussion, practical drills, tabletop exercises, and a culminating Full Mission Profile (FMP) scenario. No live-fire or live-driving components are included.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

Upon completion, participating officers will be able to:

- Identify and assess threat types, pre-attack indicators, and risk factors.
- Demonstrate protective formations, movement tactics, defensive principles, and safe equipment handling.
- Detect and respond to surveillance activities and ambush indicators using immediate-action principles and communication discipline.
- Deliver medical care under stress using TCCC fundamentals (protectee, self, teammate).
- Conduct full advance planning for sites, routes, vehicles, and multi-agency coordination.
- Execute an operationally realistic Full Mission Profile integrating planning, movement, medical, and decision-making elements.

Day 1 — Foundations, Legalities & Medical Fundamentals (8 hours)

Day 2 — Surveillance Detection, Ambush Awareness & Communications (8 hours)

Day 3 — Close Protection Tactics, Advance Planning & Full Mission Profile (8 hours)
