Crime victims with disabilities experience domestic violence, dating violence, sexual violence or stalking at higher rates than victims without disabilities, yet many survivors still face major barriers to safety, justice, and healing. These barriers can include challenges with communication, accessibility, and gaps in community response systems.

Overall, the goal is to help participants feel more confident in creating safe, inclusive, and supportive environments for victims with disabilities.
