This 3-day / 24-hour instructor certification course immerses firearms instructors in the principles and safety protocols of conducting live-fire, team-based tactical drills and scenarios. Going far beyond most basic instructor courses, this program bridges the gap between traditional firearms training and real-world tactical application with multiple officers. Participants will be shown how to design effective training to incorporate their own agency tactics into live-fire range exercises. Instructors leave with practical tools to build the confidence, coordination, and competence in their students that only live-fire experience can provide.

This course is approved by the NRA LE Division for 24 hours of continuing education credit.

NOTE: This course requires the use of carbines / rifles. Students don't need to be certified as a rifle instructor to attend. However, students must have successfully completed a rifle operator certification course of 16+ hours to attend this course.

- Training responsibilities
- Three critical components to live-fire team-based drills and scenarios
- Student preparation
- What types of tasks/scenarios to conduct
- Conducting drills vs conducting scenarios

- Converting solo drills into team drills
- Developing and safely conducting tactical team drills and scenarios
