KLEAP Assessors will undergo refresher training by reviewing agency accreditation files. The agency's Accreditation Manager/Team is encouraged to attend the training and sit with assessors assigned to review their files to receive feedback, discuss any issues or concerns discovered within the files, and ask questions. This is an excellent opportunity to set your agency up for success.

Agencies may submit up to 10 completed accreditation files for review. Files must be submitted via email to the KLEAP Program Director by Friday, March 14, 2025.

A Road Map to a Successful Assessment

The pressure for a successful assessment is real. This class provides guidance for agencies to follow to transform an ambiguous and tentative accreditation process into a successful on-site assessment. Discover why a properly planned Mock Assessment can be your agency's secret weapon. Learn how to develop a "triage" plan after your Mock. Methods to know when your agency is ready for their mock and on-site assessment.

Accreditation Management Made Easy

Accreditation management is an on-going process with a myriad of moving components that must be managed cohesively. This class breaks down each component, shows how components effect outcome, and provides a proven project plan for successful accreditation management.

Accreditation Manager Hands-On Training

Assessor Refresher Training - Agency File Review

KLEAP Assessor refresher training is offered to help KLEAP Assessors review the process and practice file review. This class will consist of reviewing actual agency submitted files. Each KLEAP participating agency may submit 10 accreditation files to be review by a KLEAP Assessment Team. Accreditation Managers are invited to sit in on this class to hear assessor concerns, comments, and recommendations.

Easy Analysis & Data Collection Revealed

Accreditation requires Analysis reporting in several high-liability areas. Learn to harness the power of data collection and analysis report writing with the skills needed to transform data into actionable insights to drive your agency's success. Writing an analysis requires a particular structure and key components which this class will help you develop.

KLEAP File Building Clinic
